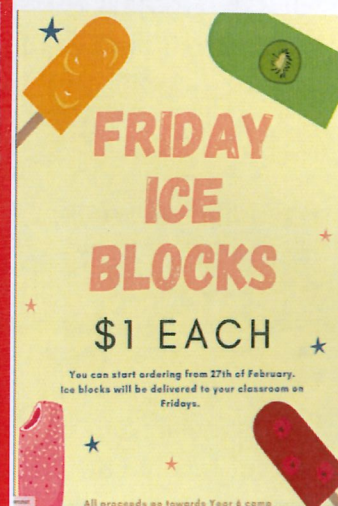


## SWIMMING TIMETABLE
