




WHOLE SCHOOL HOLI CELEBRATION

Our second strategic goal, under LEARN is All students will make at least one year's worth of progress every year. If a child is not making this progress we record that information, track that child fortnightly and consider a learning support programme or referral. Sometimes children aren't making progress due to attendance/lateness or poor health. If a child is attending school less than 80% of the time, this equates to a learning time loss of 8 weeks per year. This is significant, especially in the Years 1-3 area, where daily reading is really important. 


